GUARANTEED ADMISSION TO SJSU

As of Fall 2026, every eligible Morgan Hill Unified School District senior who meets CSU requirements is guaranteed admission to San José State University. Students applying to impacted majors may be offered admission as Undeclared.



FIRST-TIME, FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS (FRESHMAN)

Earn a high school diploma or equivalent. Your graduation date must be included in your final transcripts.

Complete the required “A-G” subject area high school courses with grades of “C-” or better

Required high school courses must be completed by the end of the spring semester prior to fall admission. Makeup coursework must be completed prior to the end of spring, as you may not use summer to make up deficiencies.

AREA	SUBJECT	YEARS REQUIRED
A	History/Social Science: Including one year of U.S. history or 1 semester of U.S. history and 1 semester of civics or American government AND one year of social science	2
B	English: English composition and literature	4
C	Mathematics: Including or integrating topics covered in algebra, geometry, and intermediate algebra	3 (4 recommended)
D	Laboratory Science: Laboratory (one biological and one physical). Integrated science and interdisciplinary courses can meet this requirement	2 (3 recommended)
E	Language other than English: Two years or through the second level of high school instruction or two one-year courses through the first level of high school in the same language. Applicants cannot mix/match semesters (e.g., one semester Spanish and three semesters French) or use partial credit units to meet the requirement. Students are encouraged to complete two years of the same language.	2
F	Visual and Performing Arts: One year or two semester courses from the following disciplines: dance, music, theatre, visual arts or interdisciplinary arts. Two semesters of coursework must be successfully completed before high school graduation.	1
G	College Preparatory Elective: Additional year chosen from the approved college prep A-G list	1

Meet or exceed the CSU Minimum GPA Requirement

California residents and graduates of California high schools will be eligible for admission by earning a 2.50 or greater “A-G” GPA.

NO TEST SCORES REQUIRED

SAT/ACT scores are not required for admission to SJSU but may be used for course placement.
