

Reinstatement & Readmission after DQ

This is a general outline of the reinstatement/readmission process for domestic students who wish to return to SJSU following disqualification. Students should work with an advisor should they have any questions about the policies and process of each step. [International Students](#) must work with the International Student Success Services.

1 Bring your SJSU GPA to 2.0 or above

Students can take up to 24 units at SJSU through Open University (OU). Prior to enrollment, students must meet with an advisor for course recommendations.

2 Petition for Reinstatement

Once the student's unofficial transcript shows a *SJSU cumulative GPA* at or above a 2.0, they should submit a petition for [reinstatement](#).

3 Apply as an Upper Division Transfer Student

After submitting the petition for reinstatement, apply as an [Upper Division Transfer student](#). Continue taking courses at a CC or SJSU until earned semester units are at or above 60 and the following requirements are completed with a C- or above:

- GE Area A1 Oral Communications
- GE Area A2 Written Communications
- GE Area A3 Critical Thinking
- GE Area B4 Quantitative Reasoning

4 Complete Former Student Returning Form

The [Former Student Returning](#) Form (FSR) helps applicants gain admission to SJSU.

5 Receive Admission to SJSU and attend Orientation

After being admitted, send transcripts and attend orientation to register for classes. Read all MySJSU messages leading up to orientation.

Example timeline after SJSU GPA is at or above a 2.0 and the petition for reinstatement is submitted

Fall semester return

October - November 30

Through Cal State Apply, submit an application as an Upper Division Transfer student in October

February 15

Complete Former Student Returning form

March

Acceptance message posted on MySJSU. Check messages weekly.

May 1

Complete Intent to Enroll through Spartan Link. You will also register for orientation.

June

Attend Spartan Experience for Transfer students (orientation) and register for Fall courses.

August

Begin Fall semester. Check the Office of the Registrar's website for exact date.

Spring semester return

August 1 - August 30

Through Cal State Apply, submit an application as an Upper Division Transfer student in August

September 15

Complete Former Student Returning form

November - December

Acceptance message posted on MySJSU. Check messages weekly.

December 1

Complete Intent to Enroll through Spartan Link. You will also register for orientation.

January

Attend orientation for Spring admissions and register for Spring courses.

Begin Spring semester. Check the Office of the Registrar's website for exact date.
