


Philosophy 110

Course Description

In this section of Philosophy 110, our focus will be:

- First, tensions between Christianity and Science in 17th century Italy, 19th century England, and 20th century United States.
- Next, ways in which different cultures view scientific and technological advances in medicine, communications, privacy invasion and privacy protection.
- There will be several online readings and videos, both non-fiction and science fiction (no physical text required)
- You will demonstrate your understanding of the materials through essay exams and a short research project.
