

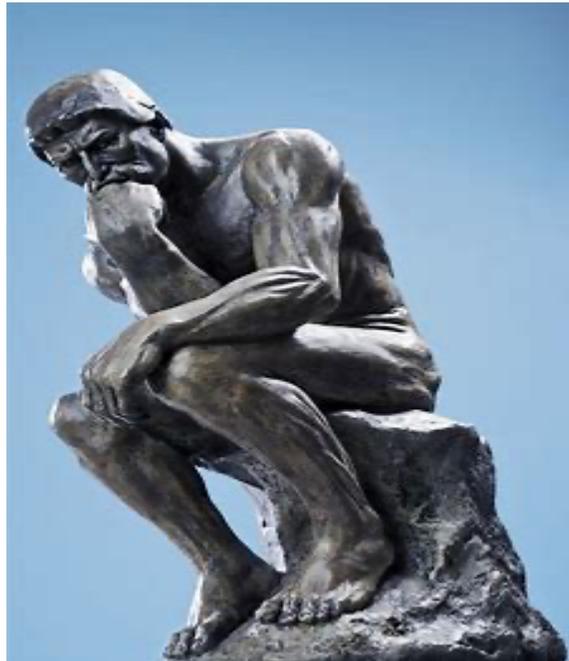
# PHIL 70A\_80 Ancient Philosophy

In this course, students explore the origins of philosophy through the ideas of influential thinkers from ancient Greece, Rome, India, and China. By reading and discussing primary philosophical texts, we will examine how different cultures have approached fundamental questions about knowledge, ethics, politics, human nature, and the good life.

Along the way, students will discover how these ancient ideas emerged within historical and cultural contexts and why they continue to shape philosophical thinking today. By the end of the course, students will gain a broad understanding of the major traditions of ancient philosophy and the enduring questions that continue to influence how we think about the world and our place within it.
