

Meeting #4: AI for Revisions

Objectives

- Explore different ways that AI can be used to aid with revisions and proofreading.
- Evaluate the usefulness of using AI for editing purposes.
- Reflect on the pros and cons of using AI as an aid to the writing process.

Agenda

 - Take the participants through the relevant toolbox section.
 - Explore different strategies for using AI in the revision process.
 - Explain methods for revision that can serve as alternatives to AI.
 - Discuss when to trust AI and when to trust your own voice.
- Activity: Peer Review Exercise, featuring AI (20 minutes) – *Seher*
 - Pair up with someone and try out using some of the strategies we talked about earlier to peer review each other's drafts.
 - Example: Something is unclear about a certain paragraph. Together, you and your partner might ask ChatGPTedu, "What are two suggestions to improve this paragraph's clarity regarding X point?")
- Final Group Reflection (10 minutes) – *Seher and Tom*
 - How did AI factor into the peer review process? Was it helpful or was it a hindrance?
